

SOCIAL SERVICES INTERNSHIPS IN PARIS, FRANCE

June 15 – July 15, 2015



Program Description

This program will give students an opportunity to gain real world experience by interning in one of the social service organizations and learn professional development and ethical skills.

Courses

Students will enroll in Social Services Internships and will receive 6 credit hrs upon completion of the program.

Special Features

- Led by UIC Kathryn Engel, Director of Internships, Applied Psychology
- Spend 3 days at the internship site per week
- Visits to Eiffel Tower, Sacre Coeur, Louvre, Notre Dame, Pantheon, Musee Marie Curie and other places in Paris
- Field trip to Versailles

Housing

Students will be housed in apartments in central Paris.

Eligibility

Students who have an overall UIC GPA of 2.5/4.0; have at least 12 hours of UIC credit; have completed two semesters of French or the equivalent or instructor's approval. Graduate students (advanced opportunities) are also eligible to apply.

Cost

The program fee of \$4,494 includes tuition, housing, airport pickup, all program related study tours, transportation pass, welcome and farewell dinners, and orientations. Additional expenses include airfare and personal expenses. Program specific scholarship available!
