Early Stage Development

Business Need: Presently Early Stage Development, at Hospira, Lake Forest, IL is engaged in developing several challenging products. These include aseptically spray- dried antibiotics, liposome encapsulated cancer and anesthesia drugs, and drug- device combination delivery systems. These products call for a combination of process know- how and physico- chemical expertise. These projects are expected to move into full development during 2015. It is essential that the pre- concept work on the projects be completed by August, 2015.

Roles & Responsibilities: It is expected that the summer intern(s) recruited are currently enrolled in an undergraduate program in one of the following disciplines:

- Pharmacy / Pharmaceutics
- Chemical engineering
- Chemistry
- Physics
- Biology

The intern(s) will be under the direction of a senior staff member, and will be given directions to formulate dosage forms, develop / scale up / transfer processes, help in selection of process equipment and components, and attempt to optimize process parameters. With a view to developing the interns, the senior staff member will help the interns understand basics of sterile dosage form development and drug delivery.
