

SOCIAL SERVICES INTERNSHIPS IN PARIS, FRANCE

June 13 – July 15, 2017



Program Description

This program will give students an opportunity to gain real world experience by interning in one of the social service organizations: previous interns were placed working with homelessness, domestic violence, services to families, children, refugees and at neighborhood crisis referral centers.



Courses

Students will enroll in Social Services Internships seminar (6 credit hrs)

Special Features

- Led by UIC Kathryn Engel, Director of Internships, Applied Psychology
- Spend 3 days at the internship site per week
- Visits to Eiffel Tower, Louvre and Notre Dame
- Field trip to Versailles

Housing

Students will be housed in apartments in central Paris.

Eligibility

Students who have an overall UIC GPA of 2.5/4.0; have at least 12 hours of UIC credit; have completed two semesters of French or the equivalent or instructor's approval. Native speakers from any Francophone country are encouraged to apply. Graduate students (advanced opportunities) are also eligible to apply. Students are required to have a pre-screening interview with the faculty as part of the application process.

Cost

The program fee \$4,420 includes tuition, housing, airport pickup, international health insurance, all program related study tours, welcome and farewell meals, one week travel pass, and orientations. Additional expenses include airfare and personal expenses. Once accepted, all students will be eligible to apply to the CEA summer scholarship via on line CEA student account.
