The Illinois Domestic Violence Hotline seeks to assemble a Youth Advisory Board consisting of 10-15 individuals ages 16-24 to aid in the development of a teen dating violence awareness campaign. Advisory Board members will meet twice in August and twice in September in order to receive training on dating violence and provide information about youth perspectives on this issue. They will also meet with a marketing/design team to provide feedback on the content, design, and dissemination of the campaign materials. The goal of this project is to increase youth knowledge of dating violence and outreach to the Hotline. Youth Advisory Board members will help roll out and promote the campaign during Domestic Violence Awareness Month in October and will participate in a couple of additional meetings and events before the end of the year.
